## What is a Skills Meet?

Skills meets introduces athletes to the world of competitive gymnastics. They are fun meets that provide your child the opportunity to show off the skills he or she is learning in class. Girls will learn a short routine of three skills to perform at each of the four Olympic events. Boys will also learn short routines to perform at each Olympic event and demonstrate their strength as well. With this non-competitive format, your child will receive a ribbon for each event, and medal at the end of each meet. Athletes will not be placed against each other. An individual trophy will be awarded at the final meet of the season!

## How will this benefit my child?

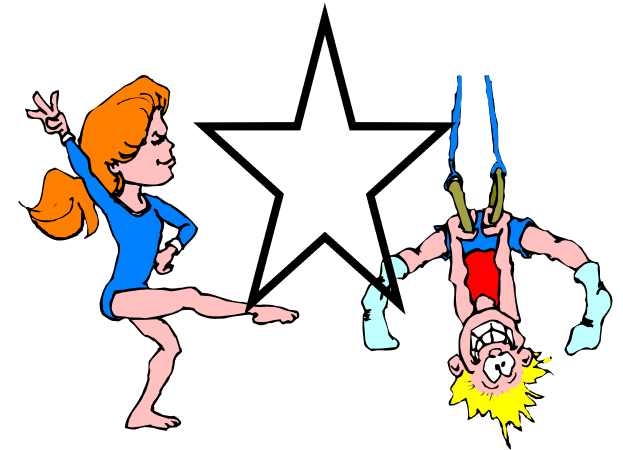

# Payment Information

\*Maximum suggests attending at least 3 meets.

\*Students enrolled in Super Mights, Mighty Mights, Superstars, Hot Shots, Hopes and Muscle Mights are required to participate in all five meets.

\*Purchase of the team uniform is suggested, but not required.

Girls - \$35.00 team leotard

Boys - \$15.00 team t-shirt

\* Meet Fees are as follows

\* \$40.00 April meet. The increase in cost will help cover purchase of the trophy.

\*First payment is due Friday, October 7, 2011. This includes the team uniform and the first meet fee.
